GENERAL

- Entries open at noon MDT on Thursday July 16, 2020.
- Entries close at 6pm sharp MDT on Monday August 24, 2020.
- Incorrect entries/changes will cost \$30.00 per team to fix from the opening entry date until August 24, 2020.
- Incorrect entries/changes after August 24,2020 up to the show date (prior to the start of the class) will cost \$50.00 each to fix. Once a class has started, no changes will be allowed unless due to a medical emergency. All replacements for medical emergencies must be approved in advance by Show Management.
- Entrants will be sent individual invoices in advance for their entry fees/extras via email. When you enter online, please ensure you submit your contact information under entries/submit rider contact info so invoicing can be sent.
- Payments must be received by September 16, 2020.
All payments received after this date will be charged a \$100.00 late fee.
If entry fees have not been received by October 1, 2020 the teams will be canceled immediately.
- Waivers must be completed by all entrants (click to submit) [Nationals Declaration Form](#). If you are a new member please complete the application for an exemption (click to submit) [Nationals Exemption Form](#).
prior to August 1,2020.
- **2020 CTCPA membership is required, if you do not have one please indicate so with your team entries and we will bill you for one.**

NEW FOR 2020

- ENTRIES OPEN JULY 16, 2020 AT NOON MDT.
- The Open Shootout will take a maximum of 60 entries. Each rider may enter four (4) times with a minimum one rider change each time. If the team capacity in the Open Shootout is not reached by August 16th at noon MDT, we will announce additional details for a potential 5th ride.
- The 8 Shootout will take a maximum of 100 entries. Each rider may enter one (1) time. If the team capacity in the 8 Shootout is not reached by August 16th at noon MDT, we will announce additional details for a potential 2nd ride.
- The requirement to qualify for riding at the National Finals is if you qualified in 2018 or 2019 then you qualify in 2020. (click to submit) [Nationals Declaration Form](#). New riders must apply to the CTCPA office for an exemption(click to submit) [Nationals Exemption Form](#).
- Open entries fees reduced to \$300 per ride
- Order of Go Copies \$2.00, available at the show office.
- If you do not have a 2020 CTCPA membership please indicate so with you online entries and we will bill you.
- Super Penner tickets now open to 1,2,3 and 4 rated riders
- Unrestricted parking pass for trucks and cars only. **NO TRAILERS!** (this allows you to park in any lot) \$60.00

RULES

We are accepting entries online up to 6pm MDT on Sunday, August 24, 2020. Online entries: www.penning.ca

Individual invoices will be emailed out to each entrant. Payment must be received by September 16, 2020 (By cheque, Visa or Mastercard or E-transfer) or you will be charged a \$100.00 late fee. Please complete the payment form (located at the end of package) and email, fax or mail back to the office CTCPA, 299 Sunvale Drive SE, Calgary, Alberta, T2X 3B8 or Fax: (403) 262-7833.

If entries are not paid in full by October 1, 2020, your teams will be immediately canceled.

All teammates will be notified of the cancellation and your name will be posted on the CTCPA website as a member not in good standing.

Please ensure that your entries are correct. Once a team is entered, any changes made from July 16 prior to August 24, 2020 will be charged a \$30.00 fee for each team changed. Changes after August 24, 2020 will be charged a \$50.00 fee for each team changed.

Any team cancellations after September 16, 2020 will not be reimbursed for any payment made and does not eliminate the obligation for full team payment.

A \$50.00 Administration Fee will be charged for all returned cheques. If we receive a NSF Cheque or Non Approved credit card payment, you will be required to submit a certified cheque within 72 hours or your teams will be canceled and no reimbursements will be given to the other teammates.

The requirement to qualify for riding at the National Finals is if you qualified in 2018 or 2019 then you qualify for 2020, (click to submit) [Nationals Declaration Form](#). New riders must apply to the CTCPA for an exemption to the qualification rules, (click to submit) [Nationals Exemption Form](#).

The CTCPA is not responsible or liable for any medical, ambulance, veterinary or other costs incurred. For certain instances, involving a medical incapacity, Show Management may approve a substitute rider. Medical Substitutions must be approved by the CTCPA Show Management prior to riding.

Payouts listed in this show package are based on projected entries and 2020 forecasted costs. Payouts will be adjusted depending upon the actual entries and actual costs in any particular class.

Abuse of any staff member or volunteer will not be tolerated. Incidents of abuse will result in a warning and/or an immediate disqualification from the event and forfeiture of all monies paid.

Unsportsmanlike conduct by a team and/or rider may result in disqualification.

Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as abuse of one's horse or cattle, excessive use of foul language, intoxication in the arena or on the grounds or any other conduct felt to be detrimental to the sport of team penning. Abuse of one's horse may include but is not limited to excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping or kicking or riding a horse that is visibly lame, sick or emaciated. Unsportsmanlike conduct may also be levied against a rider showing disrespect, physical, verbal or written abuse to a Judge, Line Official or Show Management. Any rider who shows disrespect to those parties listed in the previous sentence will be awarded an unsportsmanlike conduct and will be disqualified for that day of competition and all entry fees for the day will be forfeited. This rule is to be enforced by the presiding Judge and/or Show Management. CTCPA reserves the right to suspend any

rider from competing in the balance of the show and further, will review the offense to determine if further suspension is required.

All riders **must** display their CTCPA saddle rating tags. Tags must be visible on saddles during all runs. Only one tag may be on the saddle. Replacements for lost, misplaced or forgotten rider tags can be purchased from the show office at a cost of \$5.00 each.

Calgary Stampede policy prohibits outside liquor from being brought into the Nutrien Western Event Centre.

No motorized vehicles allowed in the barns. No dogs allowed in the Arena Building.

For the Junior Youth Class, please provide the CTCPA office with the name of an adult rider that would be willing to ride on a team with your child. There are 2 Youth riders on each team with one adult, all names will be entered into a random draw with every effort made to accommodate the requests from parents.

The CTCPA National Finals Committee reserves the right to amend/change any rule or regulation to the program at any time including but not limited to, number of teams allowed in a class, % back, distribution of payouts etc.

CLASS DETAILS

Teams in all classes other than the Junior Youth Class MUST PEN TO ADVANCE.

The time limits are as follows:

- Open Shoot-Out, 8 Shoot-Out, #14, #10 and #7 Classes will be 60 seconds.
- The #5, Jr. Youth, Sr. Youth and Century and Half Classes will be 75 seconds.

Jr. Youth Class (\$60.00/youth rider)

- Jr. Youth riders may enter up to two (2) times. All teams will be drawn.
- Each individual rider must be 12 years of age or under as of January 1st, 2020.
- Teams will have 2 full goes. The top 5 teams will advance to the Finals on Monday (depending on number of teams entered).
- Cash payouts will be awarded to the top 5 teams in the Finals (depending on number of teams entered).
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Sr. Youth Class (\$60.00/rider)

- Sr. Youth riders may enter up to two (2) times. All teams will be drawn.
- Each individual rider must be 13-16 years of age as of January 1st, 2020.
- After the first go, the top half will return for the second go. The top 5 teams will advance to the Finals on Monday (depending on number of teams entered/qualified).
- Cash payouts will be awarded to the top 5 teams in the Finals (depending on number of teams entered/qualified).
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

#14, #10, #7 and #5 Classes (\$175.00/rider for #14, \$140.00/rider for #10, #7 and #5)

- You may enter each class up to four (4) times, in each of the # 10, #7 and # 5 classes.
- 14 class riders may enter a maximum of five (5) times.
- After the first go, the top teams will return for the $\frac{1}{3}$ back. (If there are fewer than 100 teams in the class the 2nd go will be a $\frac{1}{2}$ back)
- The top 20 teams after the 2nd go will advance to the semi-finals.
- The top 10 teams will advance to the finals.
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Open Shoot Out (\$300.00/rider), 8 Shoot Out (\$300.00/rider)

- The Open Shoot Out will take a maximum of 60 entries. Each rider may enter four (4) times with a minimum one rider change each time. If the team capacity in the Open Shootout is not reached by August 16th at noon MDT, we will announce additional details for a potential 5th ride (or until the maximum number of entries have been reached).
- The 8 Shoot Out will take a maximum of 100 entries. Each rider may enter only one (1) time. If the team capacity in the 8 Shootout is not reached by August 16th at noon MDT, we will announce additional details for a potential 2nd ride (or until the maximum number of entries have been reached).
- Entrants **must compete a minimum of 3 times** in either the #14, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2020 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter either Shootout Class.
- After the first go, in the Open Shootout, the top half will return for the semi-finals and in the 8 Shootout the top third will return for the semi-finals, with the top 10 from the semi-finals advancing to the finals.
- Only the top 10 teams will receive payouts.
- There will be no Go-Round monies paid.
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Century and a Half Class (\$70.00/rider)

- This is an Open Class with one go and the top 10 moving to the Finals.
- Each individual rider must be at least 50 years old as of October 1, 2020.
- Riders may enter 2 times (although depending on size we may limit to one entry). Total class will be capped at 50 teams.
- Teams will be drawn prior to the class and drawn as evenly as possible.
- Entrants **must compete a minimum of 3 times** in either the #14, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2020 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter this class.
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.
- When entering online, please specify 1 or 2 rides in the comment section. One ride is guaranteed. Second ride is dependent on number of entries submitted.

PARKING PASSES

Parking pass option for cars and trucks only:

- Restricted lots access #30.00
- Unrestricted lots access \$60.00

Both passes give you unlimited in and out privileges to the Stampede Grounds from October 9th up to October 12th. Individual gate entry is \$15.00 per vehicle.

Camper or other accommodation type parking is available for \$100.00. Your Camper/Living Quarter parking includes one restricted lot access pass for unlimited in and out privileges to the Stampede Grounds. All units will pay the same rate regardless of size or power requirements.

Parking is not permitted any earlier than noon MDT on Thursday October 8th.

Camping Lots will be assigned to each unit based on the date and time entered and will be posted prior to the show. You can have 1 person book for the group like with the stalls. Preference given to Sponsors over \$750.00 for Infield camping spots.

All parking must be pre-ordered online.

Parking passes will be issued to each person that orders one, pick up at the Show Office. If you ordered a parking pass or camping, your name will be on a paid list at the Nat Christie Gate for a one time entry only.

If you do not purchase a parking pass, you will have to pay the daily fee. This includes coming onto the grounds to drop your horses off - No exceptions!

Parking passes are only available on a pre-order basis.

Campers/Trailers/Living Quarters must be removed from the designated CTCPA parking area, at the Stampede Grounds by 10:00 am MDT, Tuesday, October 13th. No Exceptions!

SHOW OFFICE

The Show Office will be open on Thursday October 8th from Noon until 8 pm MDT and 10 am until 2 pm MDT every other day (Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday).

STALLING

Every effort is made to place horses as requested according to the date and time entered online. Unfortunately, we are not always able to accommodate every request.

Stalls will be booked by the time stamp given when placed online. No exceptions.

Booking Stalls – If you want to be beside another competitor, please designate one person to enter all stalls for the group so that there is only 1 date and time entered. Once the designated person enters stalls for their group online, enter in the comment section or send the office an email listing the number of stalls and the person(s) they are for so the office can bill accordingly. Tack Stalls are available for 100.00 each and we require 4 riders in each tack stall. If you do not have 4 riders, we will assign other penners to share your tack stall.

Horse Stalls are \$110.00 each and will be filled with shavings prior to arrival.

Extra shavings are provided, please be reasonable, do not abuse and do not take home.

If you plan to stay over on the Monday night and need a stall, **YOU MUST** indicate numbers needed.

All Monday stayovers will be in Barn H. If you are in the Main Barn and want to stay over Monday night, you must move your horse to Barn H by 10am MDT on Monday or request Barn H when you enter online so you won't have to move.

There will be a \$20.00 charge for each stall required overnight on Monday. The CTCPA has stall access only until Tuesday at 10am MDT at which time the next booked event (cutting) starts to move in.

Horse stalls/Tack stalls will be available after noon MDT on Thursday, October 8th and all horses/tack must be removed from the designated CTCPA area by 10:00 am MDT, Tuesday, October 13th - No Exceptions!

PLEASE NOTE: If you cancel one of your booked stalls or trailer parking after October 1, 2020, you will **NOT** be reimbursed. You can sell to another participant without the involvement of the CTCPA Office.

SUPER PENNER RAFFLE

We are once again offering Six wild card teams in the #14 Class to be made up of two Super Penners and ONE lucky penner which will be drawn.

Each team will be drawn after the #10 Class on Saturday, October 10th and will consist of two 5,6 or 7 riders plus one Super Penner rider drawn from tickets sold for this event.

The combined rating of the team will be a fourteen rating.

There is no limit to the number of Tickets a Penner may purchase.

Entrants must compete minimum of 3 times in either the #14, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2020 National Finals in order to be eligible to purchase tickets.

Penners may enter as many times as you wish but once a name is drawn to fill the unknown rider position, that Penner may not be drawn again for another unknown rider position.

All proceeds from tickets purchased will be added to the #14 Class payouts.

These teams will not pay any entry fees as outlined in the entry package for their wild card team entered in the #14 Class.

No Super Penner Wild Card Team shall duplicate a previously entered team. If during the draw, this occurs, the unknown penner will be placed on the next team.

Tickets are available to all # 1, # 2, #3 or #4 rated riders for \$10.00 each or 3 for \$25.00.
