GENERAL

- Entries open at 12 pm MDT on Monday July 15, 2024.
- Entries close at 6pm sharp MDT on Friday August 16, 2024.
- **For any team changes, stall or camping you need to email ctcpaoffice@gmail.com. If you send me any texts or face book messages they will not be answered.**
- Incorrect entries/changes will cost \$30.00 per team to fix from the opening entry date until August 16, 2024. The rider making the changes will be charged the fee.
- Incorrect entries/changes after August 30, 2024 up to the show date (prior to the start of the class) will cost \$60.00 each to fix. Once a class has started, no changes will be allowed unless due to a medical emergency. All replacements for medical emergencies must be approved in advance by Show Management. The rider making the changes will be charged the fee if applicable.
- Entrants will be sent individual invoices in advance for their entry fees/extras via email. When you enter online, please ensure you submit your contact information under entries/submit rider contact info so invoicing can be sent.
- **Payments must be received by September 13, 2024.** All payments received after this date will be charged a \$100.00 late fee. If entry fees have not been received by September 23, 2024 the teams will be canceled immediately.
- The requirement to qualify for riding at the National finals is six (6) sanctioned shows attended. (Click to submit) [Nationals Declaration Form](#). **MUST BE FILLED OUT in order to ride National Finals (one per rider).**
- 2024 CTCPA membership is required, if you do not have one, please indicate so with your team entries and we will bill you for one.
- Order of Go Copies \$3.00, available at the show office.

Final "Order of Go's" will be posted on the Website after all payments have been received.

Welcome all Penners! It's time to enter our 27th Annual National Finals Show!

NEW FOR 2024

- The Show will run from Thursday, October 9 to Monday, October 14th inclusive. **Each day start time is 8am, including Thursday**
- The Second Annual CTCPA Hall of Fame Induction on Saturday night after Team Penning is finished.
- The requirement to qualify for riding at the National Finals is six (6) sanctioned shows attended in the 2024 season. (Click to submit) [Nationals Declaration Form](#).
- The Open Shootout will take a maximum of 60 entries. Each rider may enter five (5) times with a minimum one rider change each time.
- The 8 Shootout will take a maximum of 100 entries. Each rider may enter one (1) time. If class teams have not reached maximum entries, a secondary team will be allowed.
- Ride with the Pro's tickets are open to 1, 2 & 3 rated riders.
- Camping will be assigned to each rider based on the date and time entered in www.penning.ca. You can book ONLY 5 camping spots per rider. If you are wanting to camp beside each other you MUST all show up at the same time or you will not be beside each other. If you are booking camping spots for other competitors, you are responsible for payment of all stalls that you book
- Stalls - If you are booking stalls for other competitors, you are responsible for payment of all stalls that you book. Please enter in comments how many stalls you need.
- Note: The Pavilion stalls have already been spoken for as CTCPA was offered a sponsorship for this area.

RULES

We are accepting entries online up to 6pm MDT on Monday, August 16, 2024. Online entries: www.penning.ca

Individual invoices will be emailed out to each entrant. Payment must be received by September 13, 2024 (By cheque, Visa or Mastercard or E-transfer) or you will be charged a \$100.00 late fee. *A credit card fee of 3% will be charged for transactions. Please note this change is for payment by credit card only. You will still have the option to pay by cheque or e transfer without any additional fee.*

If entries are not paid in full by October 1, 2024, your teams will be immediately canceled. ***All teammates will be notified of the cancellation and your name will be posted on the CTCPA website as a member not in good standing.***

Please ensure that your entries are correct. Once a team is entered, any changes made from July 17 prior to August 16, 2024 will be charged a \$30.00 fee for each team changed. Changes after August 16, 2024 will be charged a \$50.00 fee for each team changed. Any team cancellations after September 18, 2024 will not be reimbursed for any payment made and does not eliminate the obligation for full team payment.

A \$50.00 Administration Fee will be charged for all returned cheques. If we receive an NSF Cheque, you will be required to submit a certified cheque within 72 hours or your teams will be canceled and no reimbursements will be given to the other teammates.

The requirement to qualify for riding at the National Finals is six (6) sanctioned shows attended in the 2024 season. (Click to submit) [Nationals Declaration Form](#).

The CTCPA is not responsible or liable for any medical, ambulance, veterinary or other costs incurred. For certain instances, involving a medical incapacity, Show Management may approve a substitute rider. Medical Substitutions must be approved by the CTCPA Show Management prior to riding.

Payouts listed in this show package are based on projected entries and 2024 forecasted costs. Payouts will be adjusted depending upon the actual entries and actual costs in any particular class.

Abuse of any staff member, volunteer, judges or board members will not be tolerated. Incidents of abuse will result in a warning and/or an immediate disqualification from the event and forfeiture of all monies paid.

Unsportsmanlike conduct by a team and/or rider may result in disqualification. Unsportsmanlike

conduct is defined as abuse of one's horse or cattle, excessive use of foul language, intoxication in the arena or on the grounds or any other conduct felt to be detrimental to the sport of team penning. Abuse of one's horse may include but is not limited to excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping or kicking or riding a horse that is visibly lame, sick or emaciated.

Unsportsmanlike conduct may also be levied against a rider showing disrespect, physical, verbal or written abuse to a Judge, Line Official or Show Management. Any rider who shows disrespect to those parties listed in the previous sentence will be awarded an unsportsmanlike conduct and will be disqualified for that day of competition and all entry fees for the day will be forfeited. This rule is to be enforced by the presiding Judge and/or Show Management. CTCPA reserves the right to suspend any rider from competing in the balance of the show and further, will review the offense to determine if further suspension is required.

All riders **must** display their CTCPA saddle rating tags. Tags must be visible on saddles during all runs. Only one tag may be on the saddle. Replacements for lost, misplaced or forgotten rider tags can be purchased from the show office at a cost of \$5.00 each.

Calgary Stampede policy **prohibits outside liquor** from being brought into the Nutrien Western Event Centre.

No motorized vehicles allowed in the barns. No dogs allowed in the Arena Building.

The CTCPA National Finals Committee reserves the right to amend/change any rule or regulation to the program at any time including but not limited to, number of teams allowed in a class, % back, distribution of payouts etc.

CLASS DETAILS

Teams in all classes other than the Junior Youth Class MUST PEN TO ADVANCE. The time limits are as follows:

- Open Shoot-Out, 8 Shoot-Out, Open Handicap, #10, and #7, All Pro All Draw and Ride with the Pros will be 60 seconds.
- The Century and a Half class, 5 class and Jr. Youth and Sr. Youth will be 75 seconds.

Jr. Youth Class (\$60.00/youth rider)

- Jr. Youth riders may enter up to two (2) times. All teams will be drawn.
- Each individual rider must be 12 years of age or under as of January 1st, 2024.
- Please provide in the comment with youth entry the name of the designated adult rider. If no adult rider is provided, we will match up with adult riders entered in the class. Every effort is made to match youth rider up with their adult rider for at least 1 run.
- Teams will have 2 full goes. The top 5 teams will advance to the Finals on Monday (depending on number of teams entered).
- Cash payouts will be awarded to the top 5 teams in the Finals (depending on number of teams entered)

- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Sr. Youth Class (\$60.00/youth rider)

- Sr. Youth riders may enter up to two (2) times. All teams will be drawn.
- Each individual rider must be 13-16 years of age as of January 1st, 2024
- After the first go, the top half will return for the second go. You must pen cows to advance. The top 5 teams will advance to the Finals on Monday (depending on number of teams entered/qualified).
- Cash payouts will be awarded to the top 5 teams in the Finals (depending on number of teams entered/qualified).
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Open Handicap, #10, #7 and #5 Classes (\$185.00/rider for Open Handicap, \$150.00/rider for #10, #7 and #5)

- You may enter each class up to five (5) times, in each of the Open Handicap, # 10, #7 and # 5 classes. **If time warrants, an additional 6th team will be allowed in certain classes upon approval of the board.**
- Open Handicap class riders may enter a maximum of five (5) times there is a 0.50 Handicap.
- After the first go, the top teams will return for the $\frac{1}{3}$ back. (If there are fewer than 100 teams in the class the 2nd go will be a $\frac{1}{2}$ back)
- The top 20 teams after the 2nd go will advance to the semi-finals.
- The top 10 teams will advance to the finals.
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.

Open Shoot Out (\$500.00/rider), 8 Shoot Out (\$330.00/rider)

- The Open Shoot Out will take a maximum of 60 entries. Each rider may enter five (5) times with a minimum one rider change each time. If the team capacity in the Open Shootout is not reached by August 4th at noon MDT, we will announce additional details for a potential 6th ride (or until the maximum number of entries have been reached). **Shootout will be aggregate time until the top 10 teams. Finals Top Ten will be clean slate and teams select their cow number and it will also be your order of go. Teams will be drawn at the Hall of Fame Banquet.**
- If riding the Open Shoot Out you automatically be entered in the All-Pro Class. (\$300 for 3 draw teams)
- The 8 Shoot Out will take a maximum of 100 entries. Each rider may enter only one (1) time. If the team capacity in the 8 Shootout is not reached by August 4th at noon MDT, we will announce additional details for a potential 2nd ride (or until the maximum number of entries have been reached).
- Entrants **must compete a minimum of 3 times** in either the Open Handicap, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2024 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter either of the Shootout Class, Ride with the Pros and All Pro All Draw Class.
- Only the top 10 teams will receive payouts.
- There will be no Go-Round monies paid to base classes only: Open handicap, 10, 7 and 5.

- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition. Excluding the open shootout.

Century and a Half Class (\$70.00/rider)

- This class is for riders that are 50 or older with one go and the top 10 moving to the Finals.
- Each individual rider must be at least 50 years old as of October 1, 2024
- Riders may enter 2 times (although depending on size we may limit to one entry).
- Total class will be capped at 50 teams.
- Teams will be drawn prior to the class and drawn as evenly as possible.
- Entrants **must compete a minimum of 3 times** in either the Open Handicap, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2024 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter this class.
- Teams will carry their accumulated times throughout the competition.
- When entering online, please specify 1 or 2 rides in the comment section. One ride is guaranteed. Second ride is dependent on number of entries submitted.

****NEW** All Pro All Draw Class for riders rated 4,5,6 and 7 (\$300 for 3 draw teams)**

- This class is restricted to 4, 5, 6 and 7 rated riders only.
- First go, half back and top ten advancing to the finals Monday October 14th
- If you are a 4, 5, 6 or 7 entering the Open Shoot out it is mandatory, you will be entered in the All Pro All Draw Class
- You do not have to enter the Open Shoot Out to enter the All Pro All Draw Class but you do need to be a 4, 5, 6 and 7
- Entrants **must compete a minimum of 3 times** in either the Open Handicap, #10 or #7 classes at the 2024 National Finals in order to be eligible to enter this class.
- You can enter this class as many times as you choose.

Ride with the Pro's RAFFLE

- 10 Runs in the Ride with the Pro's.
- Team will consist of 2 higher rated riders and one lucky penner (rated 1, 2 or 3) that has been drawn from tickets purchased.

Each team will be drawn during the All Pro All Draw Class Sunday Night, October 13th and will consist of two 5,6 or 7 rated riders plus one lucky penner rider rated 1, 2 or 3 will be drawn from tickets sold for this event.

There is no limit to the number of tickets a Penner may purchase.

Entrants must compete minimum of 3 times in either the Open Handicap, #10, #7 or #5 classes at the 2024 National Finals in order to be eligible to purchase tickets.

Penners may enter as many times as you wish but once a name is drawn to fill the unknown rider position, that Penner may not be drawn again for another unknown rider position.

All proceeds from tickets purchased will be in payouts to first place team only.

Tickets are \$30.00 each or 3 for \$65.00. Should we increase the amount

Calcutta Monday!!!

Calcutta will run immediately before the beginning of the finals Monday Afternoon! Pre-Register prior to the Calcutta event. Please note, if all Calcutta bidders have not paid than our board will not pay out the Calcutta until all parties have paid.

PARKING PASSES

- Parking passes will be \$50.00 order thru www.penning.ca
- Parking passes will be issued to each person that orders one, pick up at the Show Office. If you ordered a parking pass or camping, your name will be on a paid list at the Nat Christie Gate for a one-time entry only. Additional parking passes can be purchased at the show office during the event.
- This includes coming onto the grounds to drop your horses off - No exceptions!

CAMPING

Note: Preference will be given to Sponsors over \$1000.00 for Infield camping spots.

- Camper or other accommodation type parking is available for \$200.00. Your Camper/Living Quarter parking (includes one parking pass) for unlimited in and out privileges to the Stampede Grounds and power. Camping will also be available to the first 30 campers that wish to use generators in the infield, the cost will be \$150.00. Please note: Generator camping will be on the far south side in the infield.
- Camping will be assigned to each rider based on the date and time entered in www.penning.ca and will be posted prior to the show. You can book **ONLY** 5 camping spots per rider.
- If you are wanting to camp beside each other you **MUST** all show up at the same time or you will not be beside each other.
- **Campers/Trailers/Living Quarters must be removed from the designated CTCPA parking area, at the Stampede Grounds by 08:30 am MDT, Tuesday, October 15th. No Exceptions!**

Parking is not permitted any earlier than noon MDT on Wednesday October 9th, 2024

STALLING

Note: The Pavilion stalls have already been spoken for CTCPA was offered a sponsorship for this area.

- Every effort is made to place horses as requested according to the date and time entered online. Unfortunately, we are not always able to accommodate every request.
- Stalls will be booked by the time stamp given when placed online. No exceptions.
- Booking Stalls – If you want to be beside another competitor, please designate one person to enter all stalls for the group so that there is only 1 date and time entered. Please comment in penning.ca how many stalls you need.
- Tack Stalls are available for \$150.00 each and we require 4 riders in each tack stall. If you do not have 4 riders, we will assign other penners to share your tack stall.
- Horse Stalls are \$150.00 each and will be filled with shavings prior to arrival.
- Extra shavings are provided, please be reasonable, do not abuse and do not take home.
- If you plan to stay over on the Monday night and need a stall, **YOU MUST** indicate numbers needed. **If you do not indicate you need a Monday stall and end up staying a \$30.00 charge per stall will be charged to your credit card. If you did not indicate you need a stall you will not be able to stay over as the Stampede Board will charge us double which in turn, we will charge that cost back to you.**
- All Monday stayovers will be in Barn H. If you are in the Main Barn and want to stay over Monday night, you must move your horse to Barn H by 10am MDT on Monday or request Barn H when you enter online so you won't have to move.
- There will be a \$30.00 charge for each stall required overnight on Monday.
- The CTCPA has stall access only until Tuesday at 10am MDT at which time the next booked event (cutting) starts to move in.
- Horse stalls/Tack stalls will be available on Wednesday, October 9th and all horses/tack must be removed from the designated CTCPA area by 08:30 am MDT, Tuesday, October 15th
- No Exceptions!

PLEASE NOTE: If you cancel one of your booked stalls or trailer parking after September 27, 2024, you will **NOT** be reimbursed. You can sell to another participant without the involvement of the CTCPA Office.
